**Pilgrimage to Knock** I will be in Knock from Monday to Friday and will remember all of you in my Masses and prayers. When he was asked what the most important mission of the Pope was, Blessed John Paul II replied “the most important mission is to pray”. When Our Lady appeared in Knock accompanied by St. Joseph and St. John, priest and evangelist, her hands were raised like the hands of a priest in prayer. At the centre of the tableau, during which not a word was spoken, stood the altar and on the altar the paschal lamb, the lamb of sacrifice and gathered round the altar, a choir of angels. By this vision affirmed the absolute centrality of the Holy Mass to the life of every Christian. During these nine days of prayer until Pentecost Sunday, let us gather truly with Mary in the “Upper Room” and pray for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit. If you cannot get to Mass every day then pray at least some part of the Rosary.
