Ash Wednesday is Wed 9th Mar
and is a day of fasting and
abstinence. Thurs 10th March is
the feast of St. John Ogilvie. The
period for fulfilling the Easter
precept of Communion begins. A
plenary indulgence is available for
all those who devoutly make the
Way of the Cross. Second
collections during Lent will be for
sick and retired clergy, except 4th
Sunday, when collection will be
for Papal and Episcopal Charities
(incl. SCIAF). Lent prepares for
Easter, for the Lenten liturgy
disposes both the faithful and
catechumens to celebrate the
Paschal mystery as the centre of
the liturgical year and of the
Christian life. Preceded by the
Penitential Rites of Ash
Wednesday and preparatory days
following, Lent opens formally on
the First Sunday and continues for
40 days to Holy Thursday
