**Fair Trade** "For a long time the Parish Pastoral Council, along with the Justice and Peace Group, has been in favour of declaring St. Lucy's a "Fair Trade Parish". Last Spring we issued a consultation paper to members of the parish. While the number of responses was small, those who did reply were all in favour. At its meeting on 28<sup>th</sup> Aug. the Council agreed to declare St Lucy's a Fair Trade Parish as from Sun, 5<sup>th</sup> Oct. This means that for all parish-sponsored activities, all food and drink products will be of Fair Trade origin, as far as we can possibly manage. In this way, we can make a difference, no matter how small, to the lives of farmers and growers in the developing world. We decided that October would be an apt time to do this as a response to the call of the Church for every Christian to be a missionary." **Published to the parish on 27<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2008**
