Holiday of Obligation

When the bishops of Scotland decided to reduce the number of holidays of obligation, they wanted to retain one for Our Lady, as she is so absolutely central to God's plan for the salvation of the world. In her graces and merits she far surpasses the graces and the merits of all the angels and saints in heaven. She is truly, as the scriptures put it, "the highest honour of our race" and we acknowledge her to be the 'Queen of heaven'. It is our belief that when her time of service on earth had ended, her body did not know the corruption of the grave but was immediately taken up into heaven. Her Assumption is, as it were, an anticipation of the resurrection of our human bodies which will take place on the last day. Before she was born, God anticipated the grace to be won by her Son's death and resurrection, and caused her to be conceived free from the stain of Original Sin. At the end of her life, he has, in Mary, also anticipated the grace of the resurrection.
