Over the next few weeks we will be celebrating the baptism of

several babies. Since most baptisms will not take place during Mass, we will welcome three of the children into the parish community this Sunday at 11am Mass. The three babies are Dominic Lyzwa, Lauren Rose Docherty, and Dillon Berry. During the Mass they will also receive the anointing with the Oil of Baptism. This oil can be used on several occasions prior to baptism. Its function is to prepare and to strengthen the soul of the person to be baptised. For this reason it is also known as the Oil of Catechumens as it is generally used for adults who are taking part in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults [RCIA] and who are called 'catechumens'.
