Consultation for restructuring of the Archdiocese

At the meeting of the PPC on Thursday, I presented the programme to the members and communicated to them the critical state for the provision of priests for the various parishes. They also received a copy of the 'road-map' the Archbishop seeks to follow during the period of consultation. Copies of the various documents are available for inspection on the notice board in the porch. The initial meeting for the members of the PPC's of the Deanery will take place in St. Flannan's, Kirkintilloch on Monday, 9th December. The Archbishop has asked us to **PRAY** for vocations to the priesthood and for each parish to set aside a day for this intention. Whenever we are

praying the rosary we are asked to offer one decade for this intention. In answer to his call, each Thursday after Mass we will pray the rosary and, commencing from next week, there will be Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament until 12 noon when Adoration will close with Benediction. Jesus always answers our prayers and he himself urged us to *"ask the Lord of the harvest to send labourers into his harvest."*
