### WORLD YOUTH DAY

According to the Rio Archdiocese, these are some of the numbers from last week's events:

#### Major Events:

- July 23: 600,000 people attended;
- July 25: 1.2 million people attended;
- July 26: 2 million attended;
- July 27: 3.5 million people attended;

- July 28: 3.7 million people attended.
- 55% of those registered were women, 45% men.
- 60% of the public registered were between 19 and 34 years.
- There were 60,000 volunteers.
- 6,500 accredited journalists from 57 countries.
- 264 catechesis sites, in 25 languages.
- 427,000 pilgrims registered, from 175 countries.
- 100 confessionals placed in the Vocational Fair and Largo da Carioca.
- 4 million hosts produced
- 644 bishops registered, of whom 28 were cardinals.
- 7,814 priests registered.
- 632 deacons.

**Economic impact:** visitors spent 1.8 billion Reals (\$780 million) (Source: Ministry of Tourism)
