He served as a priest of the Archdiocese for 62 years and died in residence at St. Patrick's, Dumbarton. He served on the teaching staff of St. Mary's College, Blairs for about 10 years and after serving as a curate in various parishes, was appointed Parish Priest of St. Flannan's, Kirkintilloch where he served for 30 years. His great moment of 'glory' was to act as Master of Ceremonies for the Papal Visit of Blessed John Paul II, who is expected to be canonised this year. He bore the cross of ill-health over the last 10 years or so with great fortitude.
