**Sunday Night Mass** Just over 5 years ago, acting on the advice of the Parish Pastoral Council, I decided to restore the Sunday Evening Mass. Out hope was that it might help young people to come to Mass. Unfortunately it has never succeeded in that aim. Whilst at the beginning the numbers could be around 50 they can now drop as low as 25/30. In principle there should only be one Mass in each parish but the priest is allowed to celebrate two Masses on a week-day or three on a Sunday if there is a pastoral need. Having listened once again to the advice of the Parish Pastoral Council and, with their unanimous approval, I have decided to write to the

Archbishop asking permission to cancel the Sunday evening Mass with effect from the first Sunday of Lent. I will notify you of his response in due course.

### Scotland for Marriage On

Friday night, along with a number of parishioners, I was able to take part in the conference at the Westwood Hotel organised by **Scotland for Marriage**. The presentations were most interesting. It is clear that all the political parties at Holyrood (*which incidentally means ‘the Holy Cross’*) are united in their opposition to retaining the traditional meaning of the word ‘marriage’. Whilst the defeat of the truth concerning the human person seems inevitable, we must not give up the fight. Please pick up a card and information sheet.

The strongest line of defence seems to be that of protecting our civil liberties and above all our right to live by our own religious beliefs and to hand them on to our children and grandchildren.
