Scottish Day of Prayer for Life Friday, 31st May
"Care for life from the beginning to the end."
Pope Francis I

A Vigil of Prayer for Life will take place this Friday, 31st May. Rosary will be at 7pm and Mass at 7.30pm. Each year all the parishes in Scotland are asked by our bishops to join in pray on this day to pray for an end to all evil attacks on human life especially through abortion and euthanasia. When the disciples had struggled in vain to free a young man possessed by a demon Jesus intervened. When the boy's father asked why his disciples could not do this, Jesus replied, *"this kind of demon can only be driven out by prayer."* After over 40 years of the senseless and brutal destruction of human life in our country we seem to have made little progress. Indeed the battle

ground is now moved from the beginning to the end of life as the agents of death never tire. We must not lose hope. In America some states have made abortion much more difficult to access. Prayer can change the world. Two of the persons who were at the very heart of the campaign in America to legalise abortion became Pro-life. The conversion of Dr. Bernard Natheson and of Norma Mc Corvey who were among the most important agents from bringing about abortion in America are surely a sign to us that we can stop this dreadful evil and the wanton destruction of the poorest and most defenceless members of our society. Did not Jesus say to us during his agony in the garden, *"Could you not watch and pray with me for one hour?"* Buffet in the hall after Mass and rosaries and Holy Hours throughout the night until 9.30am Mass on Saturday. Please join us. Any young person under the age of 18 who wish to participate in the Vigil after Mass must have a 'permission slip' signed by their parent or guardian or accompanied by a responsible adult.
