off from Heathrow bound for

Rio. We fly via Madrid arriving

10.35 hours. later in Rio on

Thurs. 17<sup>th</sup>. Our first week will

be spent in a parish in the

Diocese of Nova Friburgo,

about 100km NE of Rio, where

we will have the opportunity to meet the people and share a little in their lives. Local families, it would appear, will provide accommodation. The following week we travel to Rio itself where we, with other pilgrim groups, 'stake our claim' to a piece of the floor in a school. During this week the days will be taken up with catechesis & Mass in the mornings and the afternoons the opportunity to take part in Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation and other diverse events and, of course, to meet up with some of the millions of others sharing the same journey of faith. The highlight of the week will be the all-night Vigil at an airfield followed by Sunday Mass with Pope Francis. We then have two days at the seaside before setting off homewards on 1<sup>st</sup> Aug. We will return via San Paulo/ Madrid/London and do not arrive in Glasgow until Fri. 4<sup>th</sup> Aug.
