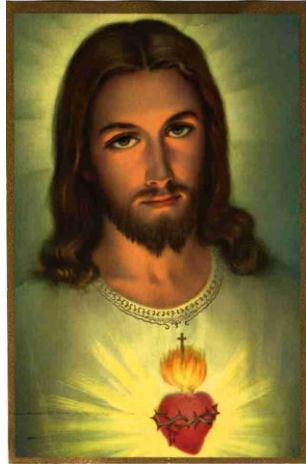

**Mass and Prayer Vigil for Vocations** on Fri. 19 April from 7-9.00pm in Our Lady of Lourdes, Cardonald. The Holy Father's theme for 2013 is: *"Vocations, as a sign of hope founded on faith.* This Vigil is organised on behalf of the Archdiocese of Glasgow by the Glasgow Serra Club whose

mission is to promote vocations to the priesthood. It will take place just before Vocations Sunday. The evening begins with a Concelebrated Mass for Vocations, followed by "Adoration for Vocations" inaugurated by Pope John Paul II, ending with Benediction and Night prayer by 9.00pm. There will two presentations during the evening on the Holy Father's theme for the 50<sup>th</sup> World Day of Prayer for Vocations.
