Sponsored Pilgrimage for Vocations to the priesthood and the Consecrated Life. On

Tues, 15th July, I will be departing from Edinburgh Airport for Santander in Spain, via Oviedo to Ferrol, the birthplace of General Franco! I will be attempting to walk the Camino Ingles (The English Way) from Ferrol in the North Coast of Spain to Santiago de Compostela, a distance of 116km. Santiago has been an important pilgrimage destination since the Middle Ages as it is considered the burial site of the apostle, St. James the Great. The suggested itinerary is:-
