Sudan Apostasy: Meriam Ibrahim's lawyers take case to International Commission

Lawyers for Meriam Ibrahim, the Sudanese woman sentenced to death for apostasy, are appealing for the African Commission on Human Rights in a bid to secure her freedom—after the

pledge that she would be released 'within days' was denied by the government.

Ms Ibrahim, 27, has been in prison in Khartoum, the Sudanese capital, since January on charges of apostasy—abandoning her Muslim faith—and adultery—because the court did not recognise her Christian marriage. On 15th May a judge ruled that she should be hanged, and receive

100lashes, even though the mother-of-two testified that she had been raised a Christian, and therefore had not 'left' Islam. The Sudanese Constitution upholds freedom of religion and 'The African Charter on Human and People's Rights' states that apostasy is not a crime. An appeal has been submitted to the court in Khartoum, but the court claimed no paperwork had been received. There have been conflicting reports about her case. Ms Ibrahim called three witnesses from her hometown, to testify to her lifelong Christianity. The witnesses were prevented from appearing."
