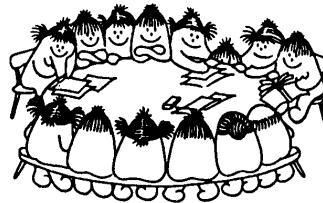

The history of the Archdiocese of Glasgow: the frequency of sacraments
As the city population has fallen, so too have Mass attendance and the celebration of the sacraments. Mass attendance is

down 51% since 1987, baptisms down 47%, weddings down 78% and funerals down 21%. On the one hand there are fewer people living in many of the parishes, and on the other hand,

changes in society seem to have distanced people from the church and its involvement in their lives. How can we make the Church more relevant to the lives of our people?
